Scientific scoring is based on the NIH R01 Grant scoring system and final scientific scores are shared with the Research Committee and Board of Directors (BOD). The LGS Foundation BOD then considers the scientific merit of each grant in the context of organizational goals and votes to fund approved research grants throughout the year. Grantees provide progress reports every 6 months to 1 year depending upon the length of the grant, which allows allocation of funds for the next grant period, and must provide final progress reports at the end of the project.
