Lennox-Gastaut Syndrome (LGS)

LGS is a severe epilepsy syndrome that develops in young children and often leads to lifelong disability and premature loss of life.

Nobody is born with LGS. It may develop over time from childhood seizures that remain uncontrolled despite aggressive treatment.

LGS affects nearly 50,000 in the U.S. and 1 million worldwide.

There is no cure for LGS but there is a hopeful path forward. Everyday the LGS Foundation is fighting to end the devastation and suffering caused by LGS.
